## AAFES management -

Based on the receipt of this survey salicitation (See row source of email below), I on very concerned about how you are protecting my privacy (including email address). Despite your posted privacy declaration (ref: http://www.adfes.com/docs/privacy.htm "We do not sell or exchange names or any other information about our online customers with third parties."), it appears as if you have violated your stated privacy policy.

From an analysis (I've been doing this since 1994) of the header portion of the email below, it is apparent that this email was received from a zoomerang.com registered IP address [63.251.58.110].

Did you provide my email address to zoomerang.com? If not, how is it that this email (from a zoomerang.com domain) came to be addressed to my email address?

I have no problem receiving email from AAFES, as a matter of fact I appreciate it; but receiving email from sameone other than AAFES is not something I have agreed to. You didn't request my permission to share my personal information with a third party, and you didn't tell me that you would be sharing my email address with this third party.

I don't know much about Zoomerang, but I have serious reservations/concerns regarding their use/protection of my email address (or any other personal information they may have obtained).

Keep in mind that Zoomerang is run by a marketing research company (MarketTools, Inc.). Even though Zoomerang's privacy statement clearly says the information will never be released to third parties, the 'never say never' rule surely applies.

If Zoomerang ever goes belly up (what, a dot-com go bankrupt???) their personal information database will become one of the most valuable assets on the auction block.

Tread carefully...

By the may, there are plenty of freeware and inexpensive shareware survey scripts (ASP, PERL, JSP) out there. I would recommend that you hire someone to create a survey tool for you, rather than trusting your customer data to a dot com anxeting research company.

Another concern -

Despite the fact that this email appears to come from AAFES (From: "Army & Air Force Exchange Service" teleconsurvey@aafes.come), this email was in fact sent from a Zoomerang domain (IP 63.251.58.110 is registered to Zoomerang.com). This deceptive practice is beneath AAFES and smacks of spam. Spammers routinely lie regarding the origin of their messages, and this message didn't come from AAFES!

My email address -

As you can see from my enail address <code>Redacted</code> to protect privacy! I am using a specifically targeted enail address in order to track the dissemination of my enail address (a span reduction/fighting technique). Since I only use this enail address in correspondence with MAFE, it is most likely that Zoomerang obtained my enail address from you.

I am seriously considering unsubscribing from any further AAFES newslatters. I hope that I won't have to do this. I appreciate the email that I do receive (when it's actually from AAFES), and consider the service to be very useful.

Unsubscribe? -

The enail that I received, indicates that I can 'Unsubscribe' from future enails from this sender. However, it is not clear whether I will be unsubscribing from future Zoomerang enails (The enail came from a Zoomerang domain), from future AAFES initiated Zoomerang surveys, or all future AAFES enails. I am hasitant to use the unsubscribe link provided (in the enail message received), as doing so may result in address delivery verification, and confirmation of my enail address/personal information by Zoomerang.

Taking the survey -

Under no circumstances will I respond to or complete an "AAFES Survey" that appears to come from someone other than AAFES.

Expectations/hopes -

I expect that you will respond to my email. I hope that you will discontinue use of Zoomerang services in order to conduct surveys. I expect that you will request that Zoomerang purge my personal information (including email address and any other personal information if any) from their database(s) in order to restore compliance with your own privacy policy (as stated on your website). I hope that this sort of incident will not happen again. I expect that you will comply with your privacy policy.

Most of all, I hope that you will restore my confidence in an institution that I have trusted for over 20 years.
